Ngāti Ruapani ki Waikaremoana whānau, hapū and iwi are a thriving people that continue to working hard towards growing its membership (visit our website: www.ruapani.com), building a strong asset base, identifying key skills and capabilities within our own people and strengthening relationships with key community, regional and national organisations.

Part of this ongoing work requires Ngāti Ruapani ki Waikaremoana to have iwi representation at various levels in a variety of organisations.

Ngāti Ruapani ki Waikaremoana Leadership group (Te Tatau Pounamu o Waikaremoana) have been invited to appoint a suitable iwi representative to the Regional Planning Committee of the Hawkes Bay Regional Council for 2017.

The suitable appointee will have:

- No criminal convictions, a clean police record and be willing to undergo a police vetting check if requested;
- Relevant skills and experience working with Iwi, Hapū & Whānau;
- Experience and qualifications relevant to this position;
- An interest in resource management and the environment;
- Willing to work closely with other Treaty Tribe representatives in the Hawkes Bay catchment area;
- Good health;
- Willing and able to attend scheduled meetings for the Hawkes Bay regional planning committee;
- Contribute and advocate for Ngāti Ruapani tribal interests and work progressively with local government structures.
- The ideal candidate must be willing to report regularly to Ngāti Ruapani o Waikaremoana Ltd directors, and to annual 'Hui a Iwi'.

For their time the appointee will be compensated a meeting fee and other reimbursements.
